

MONTHLY FIRE CHIEFS REPORT

Regular Meeting: June 18, 2024

Operations:

- We responded to 62 calls in May.
- Rec Center Kids Camp visited Station 5 last week. I have heard that it was their favorite visit.
- At the school's request, we attended the Colorado 8-man football all-star game at the school.
- It's the busy season with lots of events, the county fair, and increasing calls.
- To increase communication, training, constancy, and comradery, we instituted a 6-hour-per-month shift requirement for in-district members beginning June 1. We will seek feedback from them in a few months.

Wildland/Mitigation:

- The mitigation phone continues to be very busy.
- One of the biggest benefits of the mitigation program is the ability to have additional responders in the district. On the 14th, we had a call in Corona Heights, and because of the mitigation crew, we had personnel on the scene in 4 minutes.
- On May 13 we hosted the core team CWPP meeting at Station 3
- Andrew attended the community CWPP meeting
- We are hoping to get B57 listed in the next few days
- I won't be surprised if fire restrictions are in place soon if the weather does not change

Administration:

- The audit was done remotely due to the noise of the roof project
- Spreadsheet attached with grant updates.
- Continue to meet with USDA to work through the CDS grant funding
- The new Forester for Clear Creek Water Shed is working some days from Station 3
- Attending regular meetings to attempt to keep up to speed on upcoming legislation

- I have been spending a LOT of time doing plan reviews for county fire alarm systems and residential driveways
- We are transitioning to Fire Marshal Services for sprinkler and commercial plan reviews
