

MONTHLY FIRE CHIEFS REPORT

Regular Meeting: December 12, 2024

Operations:

- We responded to 55 calls in November.
- Station 1 Generator is complete, and the permit is closed.
- The contract for the new tender has been signed, and I have submitted initial change orders.
- The Pierce Engine is still on loan to Nederland Fire, no end date yet.
- · Annual pack tests are underway.

Wildland/Mitigation:

- With few exceptions, the weather has allowed mitigation work to continue.
- Many residents have turned in burn permits and they have been busy inspecting those.
- The new chassis was picked up and returned to the dealer at their expense.
- The new/new chassis has been ordered, and the VIN has been issued. The cost difference is \$3,463.36.
- We are down to one deployment roll to submit for reimbursement for 2025.

Administration:

- We submitted a grant for Boulder County 1B funds for a cistern at Highway 72 and 119. The total request is \$307,050. Thank you to Firefighter Harper for his hard work!
- The new man doors at Station 3 have passed inspections and are complete. Will be painted next vear.
- The new man doors at Station 5 did not pass inspection due to the exposed insulation. We will get them trimmed and call for reinspection.
- Gilpin County wants to adopt the 2024 IBC and possibly the 2024 WUI code. When this is done, we will likely adopt the 2024 IFC and alter our amendments. More to come later.
- Station 5 grant-funded fire alarm installation is complete, final testing to be done soon.
- Lots of time is being spent working through the Station 3 addition, funding, and requirements.

R&R:

- The TFPD holiday party held at the Boulder River Ranch clubhouse was great. Special thanks to Boulder River Ranch, TVFF for gifts, HCA for helping fund the caterer, and the District for the rest.
- All-Hands meeting will be held on January 17th.
- The TVFF will be hosting a Super Bowl gathering here at Station 3 on February 9th.
- Additional workout equipment has been received at Stations 3 and 4. Thank you to HCA for assisting with the funding of this equipment.




