• Consent Agenda Item: Tender/Apparatus Replacement Plans (attached): The Chief discussed our current issues with the tenders and reviewed the draft apparatus replacement plan. \$200,000 is currently added to the plan annually (includes lease purchase payment), plan shows increases to contributions in future years due to inflation/increased apparatus costs. Discussion of changes in emissions standards moving into 2027 and beyond.

Directors McKenna and Bushey had concerns about moving forward too quickly. Tabled until later in the meeting.

• Draft IGA: Peak-to-Peak Fire Mechanic

Discussion of local resident that has been working on our current fleet, consideration of moving into a shared employee with Nederland Fire. Chief Ondr will send to our attorney for their final review.

• Boulder County Mutual and Auto Aid Agreement

Director Turner moved to approve the Boulder County Mutual Aid Agreement Director McKenna, 2nd. **Motion Passed**

- Station 1 Generator installed and final inspections completed. Firmware issues; should be operable tomorrow.
- Station 3: CDS/USDA Grant Garage Bays Update: Meeting with USDA this week, an elevator may be required to be ADA compliant. Chief has also contacted a few general contractors to assist with the project.
