Station 3, Observatory: Mitigation work in progress. Roof contractor reviewed building, and discussion with historical committee regarding some necessary changes. Grant will be submitted by the end of the month, waiting for a few more support letters. Roof design and one bid has been received.

Apparatus Update: All new engines in service, one brush truck in service and one is down at Front Range Fire Apparatus. Tender repair is still in progress.
