

MONTHLY FIRE CHIEFS REPORT

Regular Meeting: November 12, 2024

Operations:

- We responded to 51 calls in October, including 2 mutual aid wildfires on our district's north border.
- Station 5 drainage and concrete project is complete.
- Plows, snowblowers, and tracked UTV are in service.

Wildland/Mitigation:

- Fire restrictions have been removed with the recent snow.
- Pile burning has begun.
- Brush 52 returned home from Wyoming on November 2nd after its second roll in Laramie.
- The new chassis for Brush 52 is scheduled for delivery in Olathe, KS, tomorrow, 11/13. However, although that is what Ford's system says, it may be up to two weeks after.
- Once we receive the delivery confirmation, we will coordinate getting it picked up.
- I submitted the FRWRM grant this week for 2 full-time Mitigation Employees. This is a 50% match. Awards will be announced March 31, 2025.
- The mitigation schedule is booked into next year.

Administration:

- We were awarded \$200,000 from the DOLA EIAF grant for the bays at Station 3.
- We met with legal counsel and confirmed that state backfill will be unlikely for 2025, it has since been removed from the budget.
- Budget workshop proposed date December 3, 12:00- 4:00PM
- I will be out of the county from November 16-23. Chief Schimanskey will be the Acting Fire Chief. I will have on-and-off availability and will check email occasionally.
- All our new doors have been installed, three doors at Station 3 and two at Station 5. The crews are currently painting them.

R&R:

- The TFPD holiday party will be held at the Boulder River Ranch clubhouse on December 6.
- Game day and Bronco's game hosted by TVFF is at Station 3, November 17 @ 1:00PM.
- Slowly reviewing SOPs.
