Regular Meeting: June 16, 2021

Operations:

- We responded to 56 calls in May.
- COVID Update:
 - o I have removed all previous COVIDs directives with the exception of the Wildland Deployment directive.
 - O We currently have adequate supplies of PPE with small amounts in reserve. Gilpin County has additional reserves, if needed.
 - O We are providing the support staff for the vaccine clinics. We are providing 3-4 members for each clinic. They are doing paperwork, directing people, assisting people to the site, etc. If the member chooses to be paid they will be paid by TFPD and we will be reimbursed through OEM via federal COVID funding.
- The 800 radio transition is going well. There has been a significant learning curve.
- Hose testing is 50% complete.

Wildland:

• Brush 57 is deployed to the Medicine Bow-Routt National Forest on a severity assignment. Lt. Smith Is the Engine Boss with three Timberline Fire Fighters.
