



MONTHLY FIRE CHIEFS REPORT

Regular Meeting: August 16, 2022

Operations:

- We responded to 76 calls in July.
- We are still waiting on guidance from insurance as to next steps with T57.
- I have provided each of you with a draft copy of the T57 AAR. Please let me know by Monday morning if you have any questions and I will send it to the department.
- All equipment was removed from T57, only a few items were damaged, and will be included in the claim.
- We have hired Nick Long as our new B-shift Lieutenant. He starts on the 23rd.

Wildland/Mitigation:

- Mitigation work continues and new jobs are being secured at about the same pace as they are being completed.
- County mitigation work around the cell tower and water tank on the north side of Dory Hill is under way.
- B56 is in Northern California. Just started their 4th roll, If we can keep the truck staffed they have stated they would like to keep it until the snow flies.
- All fire restrictions were dropped at midnight last night.
- I am working on the county mitigation funds request for next year. It is due at the end of the month.

Administration:

- We just completed the onboarding of 10 new volunteers. 5 in district 1@4s, 2@1s, 1@5s, 1@7, and 5 shift Volunteers.
- Lots of deployment billing is happening.
- Audit is done, signed, and submitted to the state.
