

MONTHLY FIRE CHIEFS REPORT

Regular Meeting: June 13, 2023

Operations:

- We responded to 45 calls in May. Average response times district wide was 9:44.
- We responded to a small house fire on the 9th. A quick response and quick action by crews kept the damage to a minimum.
- With the wet weather we are responding to more residents burning slash without permits or snow cover.
- Working with county GIS and dispatch to build the new CAD system.
- New Temporary Firefighter starts this week.

Wildland/Mitigation:

- Chipper truck and chipper are here, training was on
- County tower project is complete, mid-county island almost complete.
- Planning for Corona Heights is in the works.
- Boulder CWPP is in progress.

Administration:

- 2022 audit took place yesterday, we should have the report at the July meeting.
- We may still need to do an amended budget for 2022, we will know in the coming weeks.
- We will be holding interviews for new firefighters in July with an August onboarding and start date.
- Recruitment push through NVFC, DFPC, newspapers, and social media.
- Chief Hinderman and I will be attending SDA annual workshop on June 15 in Granby.
- Should be picking a vendor for Station 7 fire alarm system in the next week or two. This is grant funded with a budgeted 5% match.

Training:

- Engine/Tender driver task book is completed. Copies available.
- Brush/Utility task book has been updated. Copies available.
- 4 members through S-212 class and certified as Faller 3.
- Working on a new program to qualify district Duty Officers for service above their current roles as firefighters, adding two senior FFs to the FDO program.
- June's training subject is rope rescue and backcountry rescue, hands-on field day this coming Saturday.
