

MONTHLY FIRE CHIEFS REPORT

Regular Meeting: August 23, 2023

Operations:

- We responded to 67 calls in July. Average response times district wide was 11 min 40 seconds.
- New brush trucks are in service and have been used on several calls. They are serving the district well.
- We have a resident in the cottage, he will be providing 48 hours per week at station 5 and doing mitigation work on other days.
- Station 9 will have a brush truck in it in the next few days. Its currently in the shop.

Wildland/Mitigation:

- Andrew Steffe started on the 14th as our new Mitigation Coordinator.
- Timberline will be providing roadside chipping in Golden Gate Park Estates beginning September 5th and Corona Heights beginning October 2nd.
- Boulder CWPP is in progress.
- Final selection for the contractor to facilitate the Gilpin CWPP is almost complete.

Administration:

- Applied for a direct distribution grant through DFPC for some misc. equipment. No match required.
- Met with History Colorado this morning about roof grant and we will be resubmitting the end of September.
- Fire alarm at Station 7 in being installed.
- We have a Certificate of Occupancy for Station 9. Still working through the concrete issue.
- Six new recruits were brought on in August, orientation is complete, and revised onboarding academy dates are in the works.

 - Three EMT-B, three brand new (w/ one currently in EMT school @ Denver Health)
- Recruitment ad placed in Mtn Ear newspaper, Register Call ad to be placed in coming weeks.

Training:

- Two water supply trainings completed this month with St 5 staff, worked on drafting and pumping w/ new T6 engines
- Eight members through AHJ DO Pumper cone course, another cone course session scheduled for early September.
- HazMat class begins the end of Sept, 7 members going through the course.
- Joint FF2 class w/ Golden FD and GGFPD planned for November, working out details currently.
- LTs Femmer and Smith both passed DFPC DO Pumper written exam.
